She is the author of contemporary Spanish children's literature in narrative, poetry and theatre.

She is a renowned author of over one hundred titles, including short stories, poems, theatre and works for children. She is the founder of the children's poetry magazine *Cosicas*.

Her works have been translated into more than 15 languages, and among these, the book *Cuanto cuento* ('As Much As I Can Tell') stands out, with its playful re-tellings of traditional tales and characters, reinvented from a creative and entertaining perspective.

She is a renowned author of children's literature, who has won several awards, including the *White Raven*, awarded by the International *Jugend Library in München* and the Gold Medal at the International Latino Book Award..
